LISTENING Ears facing outwards but flicking back and forth. He is relaxed and listening. His eyes are relaxed and he has no tension on his mouth.	VOCALISATION Mouth open, lips wrinkled back, eyes and ears facing forward. This might be accompanied by peeing and swishing of the tail. He is calling to communicate.
		
ACCEPTANCE Ears back but relaxed, tongue is out, eyes are relaxed. He may be resting on or his legs.	ANNOYED Ears pinned back he is starting to show annoyance at something. This might be accompanied by a swishing tail.	THREAT Ears flat back, face wrinkled up, teeth on show. Watch out for the tail, this may be preceded by swishing and then a tucked tail.
