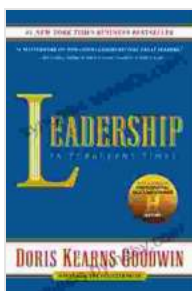


# Leadership In Turbulent Times: Lessons from America's Greatest Presidents

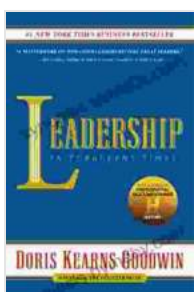


- **Vision:** The ability to articulate a clear and compelling vision for the future.

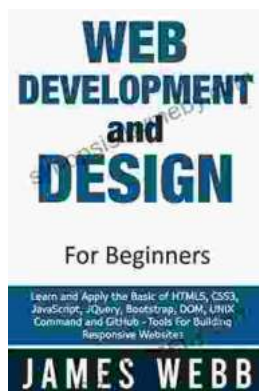
