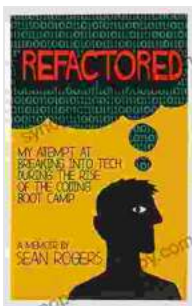


My Attempt At Breaking Into Tech During The Rise Of The Coding Boot Camp

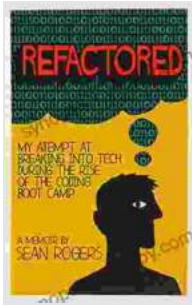

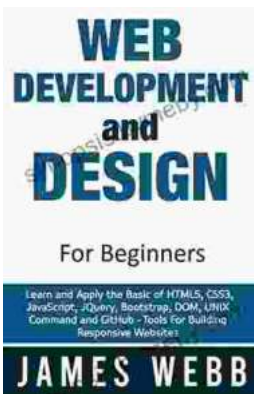
